This Letter of Agreement (LOA) contains basic provisions which will guide the working relationship between both parties and the use of resources provided.

St. Louis District Dairy Council (SLDDC) agrees to assume the following responsibilities:

1. Provide 1 commercial grade **immersion blender**, and one 22-qt storage container, to increase access to and consumption of milk and yogurt at school breakfast and/or school lunch, via smoothies.
2. Provide smoothie **recipes** that can be credited at breakfast and lunch as part of a reimbursable meal.
3. Provide **promotional materials** for the cafeteria.

As the program recipient, I agree to assume the following responsibilities:

1. Agree to use the blender to make yogurt and/or milk- based smoothies. The blender becomes the property of the school, and the school is responsible for all maintenance and service.
2. **Make yogurt and/or milk-based smoothies** and offer them as part of the breakfast or lunch meal, at a minimum of **2 times per week**.
3. Agree to **use the recipes provided by SLDDC**.
4. **Initiate** the program **by September 30, 2026**, and continue to make and offer smoothies for the duration of the 26-27 school year.
5. Complete all required qualitative and quantitative reporting and evaluation components on the use and impact of the equipment, using the forms provided by SLDDC and according to the timeline provided by SLDDC.
6. Allow one (1) site visit by SLDDC staff to observe/monitor the smoothie program and its progress.
7. Submit at least 3 photos taken of the smoothie program/or events that were part of the program (within school regulations) for use in promotional and informational materials.

NOTE: By completing this form, you are not guaranteed to be a program recipient for Servin' Up Smoothies. SLDDC will consider all requests before determining participants for this program.

I understand this Letter of Agreement must be signed and returned to St. Louis District Dairy Council before any resources listed above will be awarded. I also understand that the failure to implement the agreed upon strategy(s) may result in the mandatory return of equipment.
